### FIA World Endurance Championship – LIVE

The much-anticipated FIA World Endurance Championship gets underway this month with the opening round of the season taking place at the fantastic Silverstone circuit. Following Nissan's decision to join Toyota, Audi and Porsche in the WEC, there will be four manufacturers going head-to-head in the top LMP1 class this year. Meanwhile, AF Corse/Ferrari will be defending their LMGTE Pro category title as the likes of Aston Martin and Porsche attempt to steal the crown.
