### Goodwood Festival of Speed

The Glastonbury of motorsport returns to the West Sussex countryside in June as Goodwood House opens its gates to some of the biggest names in racing. As usual, Lord March will pull out all the stops for the annual event, which this year boasts an absolutely incredible line-up of stars. The likes of Valentino Rossi, Casey Stoner and Giacomo Agostini take on the famous Hillclimb on two wheels, while Derek Bell, Richard 'The King' Petty and five Formula 1 teams will be representing the four-wheeled world.

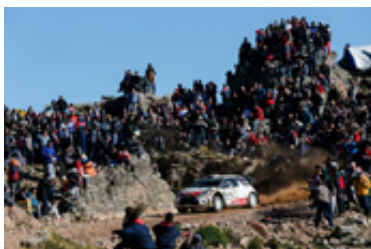
### **Renault Sport Trophy**
